    1. Currently at 175. 45 new families. Apx 13 choice. 3 new (April 15 cutoff)
  - d. Little Chute Follow up- Mathematics
    1. Concern voiced earlier(informally) that kids were behind once getting to high school. Kevin has reached out for data but have not received any that support this.
  - e. Student/parent handbook corrections needed- page 42 and 44
    1. updates needed regarding Peanut Butter/allergies
  - f. 2021/22 School Schedule- draft
    1. Kevin handed out a draft to review. Will finalize and get out in the next few weeks.
  - g. SJS uniforms
    1. No issues, going well. Adding a separate category for clubs in the 21-22 parent/student handbook.
  - b. Potential blended classroom in 2021/22
    1. 1<sup>st</sup> grade has low number of enrolled.
    2. Will continue to market the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade tuition incentive.
    3. If needed, will look to blend classrooms next year to make up for small case size
