

Then OCIA is the place for you!

What is OCIA?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which the Catholic Church welcomes new members into its midst and/ or completes the process of Christian initiation. During the process of initiation, a person grows in knowledge of the teachings of the Catholic Church, explores the meaning of the Scriptures for daily life, develops friendships with members of the parish community, learns to pray and worship in the Catholic tradition and discovers the joy of serving others.

OCIA is also for anyone interested in learning more about the Catholic faith or learning about faith in a new way.

The OCIA Process

The process of becoming Catholic consists of a gradual process of spiritual and intellectual growth that occurs over a series of five (5) periods.

Inquiry

This period allows you to ask questions and make inquiries about the Catholic faith before making any kind of commitment.

Catechumenate

This period signifies your commitment to begin your journey of becoming fully initiated into the Catholic Church by studying Sacred Scripture and Church Doctrine.

Purification and Enlightenment

This period is signified by greater spiritual reflection as you prepare for reception into the church at Easter. This period occurs during Lent and includes reflecting on a series of Gospel-based meditations.

Initiation

This period is the celebration of the entire process as you are received into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil Mass. You are fully initiated through the Sacraments of Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation.

Mystagogy

After reception into the Church at Easter, the rest of your life is spent reflecting and learning more about the mysteries of the Mass and the Sacraments that you now participate in fully.
