Welcome to the 2023-24 school year!!

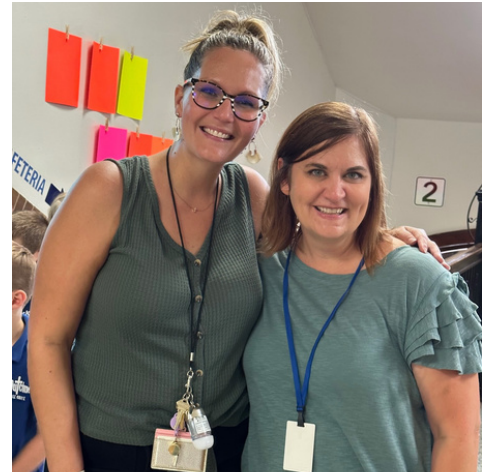
